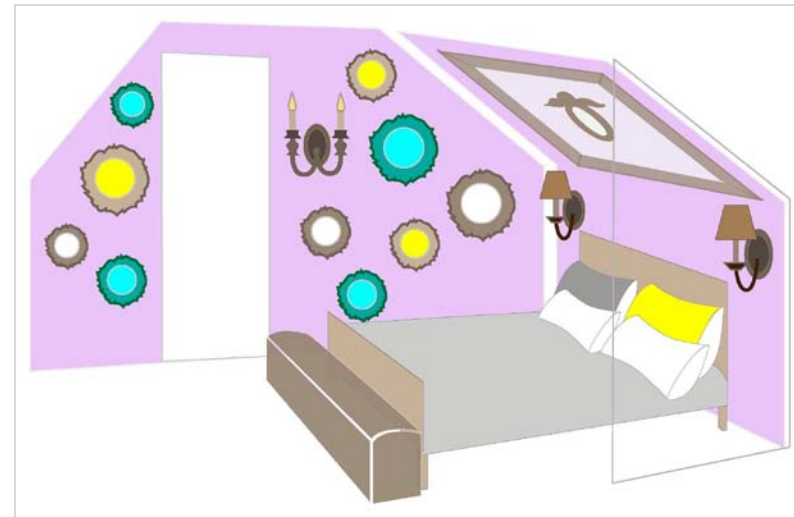

ATTIC BED AREA – AFTER – ABOVE PICTURE

The main colour scheme of this space is light pink. To compliment it, the colour of off white, gold, yellow, natural white will enhanced and transform this space for a calm, classic yet modern ambience. The attic roofing line can be used to create wall decorative panels – with group D Items for a classic yet sophisticated inspiration. These panels have two coloured options – light grey tone for inset or yellow as shown here. The bed frame has to show the legs, to enlarge the space. Bedside can be a step ladder – as in living area. Lighting source on either side of bed to have lamp shade for a classic elegance – the function of these two lights is for reading in bed when needed – The end of bed stool, can be padded and with storage as a trunk. The right wall of the entry door s decorated with colourful ceramic bowls and to light up the room on the way in, a twin classic candle light is part of this featured wall. The other option is to have photo of family and friends on this wall with beautiful photo frame of different dimensions. Simplicity, modern elegance is the style.



WALL FACING BED – AFTER

Array of floating shelves are introduced to this wall for storage as well to reduce the clutter of any other storage item such as a cabinet. This will help to enlarge the space. Basket, woven soft basket, stainless steel pot, modern and colourful storage units are used for an orderly repetition for a de-cluttering purpose.

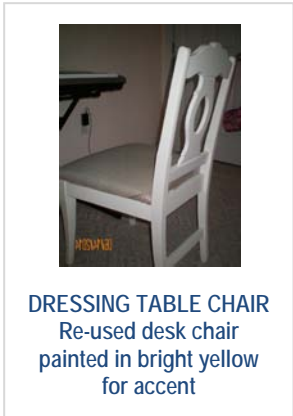

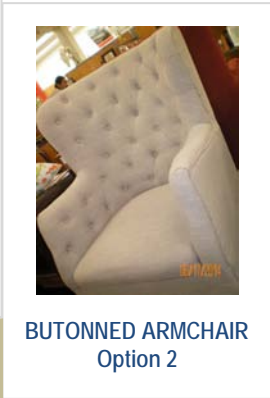

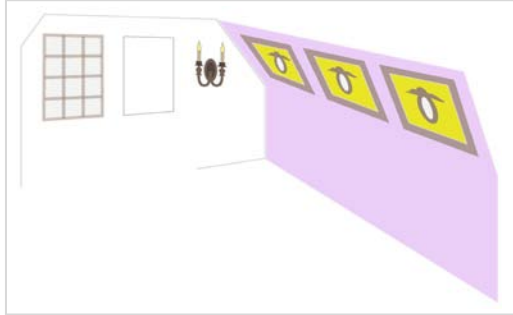

ATTIC BED AREA – THE END WALL AFTER
The wall next to the built-in wardrobe to have a picture frame with identical dimension as the dimension of the window as shown here – the picture theme could be a decorative motif, a black and white or a colourful botanical drawing.. This is created to balance this wall for aesthetic purpose. A classic buttoned armchair can be placed at the corner area for morning and afternoon reading whenever it is needed. To light up this area, a table lamp and a wall light are introduced as shown here. This white modern table lamp is an eclectic addition with a reference to the living area.
