Brief – energy efficient lighting to an extension of a double fronted Victorian home

Areas – living, dining, kitchen, hallway, stair case, guest bed, inner courtyard and back decking

Result – modern simplicity on energy efficiency

Price point – over AUD \$1.4 million project
